Course Offerings

Adv. Band / Theory

All students in the band program register for this course. Based on skill level, they will be placed into either the Symphonic or Concert Bands which meet at separate class times.

Adv. Percussion

Percussion students register for this class and meet separately. They receive specific instruction for percussionists.

Adv. Jazz Band

The Jazz Band is the premier ensemble in the band program. Students perform and compose in a variety of jazz styles.

Additional Ensembles

Marching Band is the most visible of all the ensembles. All students participate in marching band practices and performances. Varsity sports exemptions are granted to athletes in good standing participating with fall sports teams.

Pep Band performs at tournament basketball games. Students are required to play at least one game.

Brass Quintet performs publicly both on and off campus for holiday and civic functions.

Additional Opportunities

Solo & Ensemble assessment is held in February and allows students to excel as individuals or small groups.

University Honor Bands

hosted by UK, ECU and MSU give students experience in groups comprised of some of the best musicians in the Commonwealth.

All-State / All-District Bands and Jazz Bands are selected by audition. Students in these groups are recognized for their superior musical skills.
